

“Z Europkiem przez Europę” is an unique game in which a cheerful dragon Europek takes players on an adventurous trip across Europe. The dragon sets off from Strasbourg, the place of origin, to visit his long-lost cousin Wawel Dragon. The journey turns out to be a fascinating expedition across the continent. All players together with Europek discover interesting places, food, traditions and customs. Moving from one place to another, the game gives each player the opportunity to test and expand their knowledge of geography, history and culture of various European countries as well as expressions in different languages.

The game can be used by the teachers of different subjects as an attractive teaching aid in the classroom. The variety of illustrations related to history, geography, culture, customs and traditions allows teachers to prepare numerous interesting lessons to encourage students to get to know other languages and cultures. The set of additional, blank cards included in the game, lets teachers or students create their own set of questions based on their cultural and linguistic experience. This blank set of cards allows to customize the game to any education level and language needs.

The concept of the game follows the European Language Portfolio assumptions. The ELP works as a self-assessment tool which helps to document the path that the student takes while learning foreign languages and discovering other cultures. The European Language Portfolio as well as the game were prepared to increase the motivation of children and young people to acquire and develop new language and intercultural skills by promoting multilingualism and showing the context in everyday life.
